His previous books include *Democracy at Dawn*, *Notes From Poland and Points East*, a TLS International Book of the Year, and *African Saints, Martyrs, and Holy People*, a Black Catholic Congress Book of the Month. A former chaplain at Washington National Cathedral, he holds a doctorate in history from the University of California at Los Angeles.
